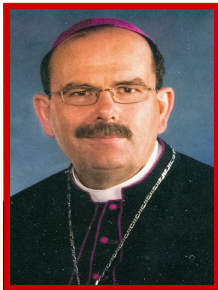

Speakers

Archbishop Albert LeGatt, D.D. was born in Melfort, SK, studied at Le Collège de St. Boniface (University of Manitoba) obtaining a Bachelor of Arts (with majors in Philosophy and French). He taught French in Ghana, West Africa, was ordained priest in 1983, was pastor in a number of parishes, Director of Vocations, ordained Bishop in Saskatoon in 2001. Appointed Archbishop of the Archdiocese of St. Boniface, Manitoba in 2009.

Peter Herbeck is the Vice President and Director of Missions for Renewal Ministries. Peter oversees the work of lay mission teams throughout the world who work to equip Catholic lay people to respond to the Holy Father's call for a new evangelization. He has traveled extensively in the U.S., Canada, Africa, and Eastern Europe for the past twenty-five years, assisting and training local churches in proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ and ministering through the exercise of spiritual gifts. Peter is the co-host of the weekly television show *The Choices We Face*, and the host of the daily radio show *Fire on the Earth* and also is a co-host of *Crossing the Goal*.

Debbie Herbeck has worked extensively in youth and women's ministry for the past twenty-five years, doing evangelism on university campuses, speaking at high school youth conferences, directing youth camps, and mentoring high school and college age women. She has spoken at Franciscan University women's and youth conferences, and women's events throughout the country. For eight years she led a weekly bible study for over 200 women and is currently the director of the Renewal Ministries School of Catholic Bible Study.

Bob Canton is a Council Member of the Vatican-based International Catholic Charismatic Renewal Services. He is also a member of the Associated Christian Therapists. He has spoken at many regional, national and international conferences and conventions and conducted retreats, seminars, Days of Renewal, Healing Rallies and Crusades not only in North America but also in Asia, Europe, Africa, Australia, Latin America and the Middle East. The Lord uses Bob powerfully in the Healing Ministry.
